We are meeting our information requirements pursuant to the EU General Data Protection Regulation which took effect on 25 May 2018, and inform you about your personal data which is processed by us.

We save and process your data exclusively on the basis of the pertinent regulations of the General Data Protection Regulation (DSGVO) and of the Austrian Data Protection Law DSG.

The company QUO Transport GmbH is a limited stock company based on corporate law and thus is a privately held company, and not an agency or public entity within the meaning of Art. 37 para. 1 lit DSGVO. Within the scope of our activity and in accordance with Art. 37 para. lit. b and c DSGVO, neither comprehensive data regarding financial judgments and penal acts, nor comprehensive, regular systematic monitoring of affected persons is carried out. For this reason QUO Transport GmbH has no duty to nominate a data protection officer.

The protection and security of your personal data is an important matter for us, in promoting a trusted and long-term relationship.

Your personal data, which we have obtained within the framework of our business relationship, is processed by us to implement the services agreed with you.

If it is necessary to save your data due to legal regulations on the provision of service, or to maintain a business relationship, this will only be done within the scope of the lawful requirements for preservation and documentation, under consideration of data economy.

We will neither sell your personal data to a third party, nor otherwise market it.

The responsible party is itself entitled to check our compliance with the data protection regulations in a reasonable manner, or to have such compliance audited by a third party. All information required as evidence of compliance with the duties established in this information bulletin shall be provided to the responsible party at no charge, and checks and inspections shall be carried out by the responsible party or by another auditor hired by us.

You have the principal rights for disclosure, correction, deletion, restriction, data portability, withdrawal and objection.

According to Art. 15 DSGVO you have the right, at any time, to request information about your personal data saved and processed by us. A separate email address is set up for such queries: [office@quo.at](mailto:office@quo.at). If necessary, additional information may be requested to confirm your identity.

If personal data is processed which is incomplete or erroneous, you may request that it be corrected or supplemented, in accordance with Art. 16 DSGVO.

According to Art. 17 DSGVO you are entitled to request the deletion of data if one of the following reasons applies:

- a) The personal data is no longer needed for the purpose for which it was collected or processed.
- b) You cancel your consent and there are no legal grounds for continued processing/storage.
- c) You file an opposition to the processing, and there are no lawful grounds for continued processing.
- d) The data was unlawfully processed.

You can request a restriction on the processing according to Art. 18 DSGVO when

- a) The correctness of the processing is disputed, and specifically for a period of time required to examine the correctness of the data.
- b) The processing of the data is unlawful, but its deletion was refused.
- c) The data is no longer needed for the intended purpose, but the data is still needed to enforce or to defend against legal claims.
- d) An opposition has been filed against the processing of the data.

According to Art. 20 DSGVO you have the right to obtain your personal data in a structured, ordinary and machine-readable format, provided the data was saved based on your consent and/or in fulfillment of a contract, and the processing is done by automated methods.

If personal data is processed based on Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b or f, then at any time you have the right of objection, according to Art. 21 DSGVO, provided there is no overriding interest in protecting the data. You have the right to cancel the delivery of advertising at any time, without providing any reason.

If you think that the processing of your data is in breach of the data protection law or that your data protection rights have otherwise been violated, you can file a complaint with the regulating authority. In Austria, this is the Data Protection Authority.

The maximum allowed time for preservation of data according to the StVM 2004 is defined as until the end of the business relationship, or until expiration of the guarantee, warranty, expiration and legal retention schedule applicable to the responsible party, that is, the company processing the data, and if applicable, until termination of any legal disputes underway in which the data is needed as evidence.

The protection of your personal data is of special concern to us. We thus process your data exclusively on basis of the legal requirements (GDPR, TKG (Telecommunications Act) 2003). In this data protection information we inform you of the

most important aspects of data processing as part of using our website.

When you contact us on the website using a form or by email, the data you provide will be stored with us for the purpose of processing the enquiry and for the event of any follow-up questions. We do not pass these data on to third parties without your consent.

Our website uses so-called cookies. These are small text files which are stored on your end device with the help of your browser. They do not cause any damage. We use cookies in order to make our website user-friendly. Some cookies will remain stored on your end device until you delete them. They allow us to recognise your browser on your next visit. If you do not want this, you can set your browser so that it informs you of the setting of cookies and lets you permit this only in individual cases. When deactivating cookies, the functionality of our website may be limited.

Our website uses the features of the web analysis service Google Analytics. The provider is Google Inc., 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway Mountain View, CA 94043, USA. In addition, cookies are used which allow us to analyse the use of the website by your users. The information generated through this will be transmitted to the provider's server and stored there. You can prevent this by setting your browser so that no cookies are stored.

We have activated the IP anonymisation feature on this website. By doing this, Google will truncate your IP address within the member states of the European Union or in other contracting states of the Agreement on the European Economic Area before transmission to the USA. Only in exceptional cases will the IP address be transmitted to a server of Google in the USA and truncated there. On behalf of the operator of this website, Google will use this information for evaluating your usage of the website, for compiling reports about the website activities and for providing further services in connection with website usage and Internet usage to the website operator. The IP address transmitted by your browser as part of Google Analytics will not be combined with other data by Google.
